When cancer hits below the belt Sue's Gift is here to help.

2020-2022 STATS:

157 applicants for financial assistance were approved, \$152,500 was spent to help people facing a gynecologic cancer diagnosis pay their bills during treatment.

181 newly diagnosed patients were matched with one of our 20 trained survivors for emotional support thorugh the Woman to Woman peer support group.

Teal Good Bags were created and distributed to newly diagnosed patients. These bags are filled with items, hand-picked by gynecologic cancer survivors, that help prepare new patients for treatment. Items include nausea aids, self-care items, coping tools, and information to encourage healthy eating during treatment.
